2016/2017 Scholarship Program

The **100 Hispanic Women, Inc. Shirley Rodriguez Remeneski Public Policy & Administration Scholarship (SRR Scholarship)** was created in collaboration with CUNY's Office of University Relations to enrich the college experience of motivated Latina students who demonstrate leadership skills, academic excellence, and financial need.

The **100 Hispanic Women Scholarship Programs** prepare scholarship recipients to succeed in their academic and professional lives, create social change, and participate in higher leadership roles. The **SRR Scholarship** provides financial support, educational programs and activities as they pursue their Associate Degree at a CUNY junior (2-year) college, and their transition to an undergraduate degree at a CUNY senior (4-year) college. Since 2002, the **100HW Scholarship Programs** have provided over 80 scholarships (approximately \$300,000 in scholarship funds) to young Latinas, helping them financially, enriching their college experience, encouraging them to graduate and postgraduate education, and to become leaders in their professions and communities.

SRR Scholarship Program Criteria:

To qualify for an SRR Scholarship, you must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Latina student currently enrolled in a CUNY Community College as a full-time undergraduate freshman pursuing Associate Degree in Public Policy & Administration or Health Care Administration;
- U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident;
- Cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher **-or-** cumulative GED score of 3000 or higher **-or-** cumulative TASC score of 3000 or higher plus 2 or more points on Writing essay;
- Recent completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher throughout CUNY Associate Degree program;
- Official transcripts submitted two (2) times each year (Fall and Spring semesters);
- Participate in two (2) annual workshops sponsored by 100HW National, Inc. and annual **SRR Scholarship** Award Ceremony; and
- Commit to transition to CUNY Senior College as full-time degree-seeking student directly upon completion of CUNY Associate Degree Program.

All interested and qualified students are encouraged to apply. Please visit www.100HispanicWomen.org, download the **SRR Scholarship** application, and submit the following documents by the deadline below:

- A completed application (Part I & II);
- Recent resume
- Recent official high school transcript (GPA must be 3.0 or higher for incoming freshmen);
- Current official college transcript and enrollment verification letter;
- Two letters of recommendation.
