INFORMATION FOR UNDOCUMENTED AND OUT-OF-STATUS STUDENTS TO ESTABLISH IN-STATE RESIDENCY FOR TUITION

A law provides in-state (resident) tuition benefits to certain undocumented students. You may qualify for the lower in-state tuition if you meet *one* of the following eligibility criteria:

- You attended an approved New York State High School for two years and graduated from an approved New York State High School and applied for attendance at CUNY within 5 years of receiving a New York State High School diploma, or
- **2.** You attended an approved New York State program for General Equivalency Diploma (GED) exam preparation, received a GED issued within New York State, and applied for attendance at CUNY within 5 years of receiving a New York State General Equivalency Diploma, or
- **3.** You were enrolled in CUNY in the Fall 2001 semester or quarter and were authorized by CUNY to pay tuition at the resident rate. Thus, a student who attended CUNY in the Fall 2001 semester and paid the resident rate does not have to satisfy either of the conditions above.

Note¹: To be eligible for in-state tuition in addition to meeting the above requirements, you must file a notarized affidavit stating that you have either filed an application to legalize your immigration status or will file such an application as soon as you are eligible to do so. Please complete the form on the following page.

Note²: All residency papers must be submitted prior to the last day of the semester. No residency forms will be accepted after the end of the semester for which the student is applying.
