Failure to provide evidence of sufficient income and/or financial resources may result in the denial of the student's application for a visa or his or her removal from the United States. **Financial documents cannot be older than three months.**

 - 2. Report of commercial rating concern
 - 3. Schedule of assets with supporting documents
