

Epson Projector Instructions

iPhone / iPad / Android:

1. Download the **iProjection App** from the [App Store](#) or [Google Play](#). Go to the next step if you have the app.
2. Connect your device to **YCWIFI** and click Forget **YCWIFIGuest**, if you are connected to YCWIFIGuest.
3. Open the iProjection app and click on **IP address** and type in the IP address for your room. The projector for your room will pop up under “projector”, click on it to connect.
4. Click on the menu option of the left, to view contents menu options.

You should now be connected, and can show Photos, Documents, Web browser contents, and live camera feed.

Note: **iOS-supported file types are:** Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Keynote, Adobe PDF, JPG, TIFF, PNG. **Android-supported file types:** Adobe PDF, JPG, TIFF, PNG.

Chrome OS:

1. Download the **iProjection App** from the [Chrome web store](#). Go to the next step if you have the app.
2. Connect your device to **YCWIFI** and click Forget **YCWIFIGuest**, if you are connected to YCWIFIGuest.
3. Open the iProjection app and click on **IP address** and type in the IP address for your room. The projector for your room will pop up under “projector”, click on it to connect.
4. Click on the menu option of the left, to view contents menu options.

You should now be connected and can show files from your computer.

Mac / Windows:

1. Download the **EASYMP Network Projection** software from the Epson website, [Mac](#) or [Windows](#). Go to the next step if you have the software.
2. Connect your device to **YCWIFI** and click Forget **YCWIFIGuest**, if you are connected to YCWIFIGuest.
3. Open the software, click on **Manual Search** and type the IP address for your room in the box, and click **Search / OK**.
4. The projector for your room will pop up on the list, click on it and click **Join / Connect** to connect.

You should now be connected and can files from your computer.
