Your 2021–2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called "Verification". If there are differences, your Financial Aid Office may require additional documentation and your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You will not receive federal financial aid until all verification requirements are met and the necessary corrections made.

- 3. Complete Sections A-D of this worksheet you and one of your parents must sign the Section E certification on page 3 of the worksheet. Collect the documents required for Section F on page 3 but do <u>NOT</u> complete that section in advance.
- 4. Submit the completed worksheet, tax return transcript(s) and any other required documents to the Financial Aid Office at your college. You will complete Section F in person at that time.
