Mission of Institutional Advancement:


To support the teaching, research, and community service of York College by strategically aligning the College with individuals, corporations, and foundations that possess similar values and aspirations and are inclined to give their resources.


Goals:

Advancement Process




Growth in Total Giving and Alumni Giving, 1988–2018 (1988=100)
