Bursars Office – Office appeared to be very secure
devoid of potential workplace violence incidents
arising for public interaction.
Counseling Office - Due to potential of disputes in
this office panic buttons should be installed.

A sign should be placed near the main door identifying that door as the only door for public use. There should be an immediate response from public safety, when a request is made to cut on the hallway lights on the 4 th floor that are not automatic. Registrar's Office - Due to potential of dispute in this office panic buttons should be installed. Bursars Office – Office appeared to be very secure devoid of potential workplace violence incidents arising for public interaction. Counseling Office - Due to potential of disputes in this office panic buttons should be installed. Performing Arts Building 2 nd Floor Office – This office has two entrances, recommendation that only one entrance is used to service the public. A sign should be placed outside of the main entrance, identifying that entrance as the only entrance and exit for the public. Health & Physical Education Building Recommended that the public safety officer stationed in the lobby; notify the main office of visitors prior to allowing any visitors into to the main office. Science Building The alarm on one of the emergency doors is not working and should be repaired. Student Financial Services - Requires secondary exit and a more securable entrance door. Due to potential of dispute in this office panic buttons and phones at counter should be installed. Consideration for installation of glass partition at counter should be made. Office staff was aware of how to contact Public Safety. Registrar's Office -Consideration for installation of

How the identified risk factors have been/ are being addressed	In lieu of panic buttons, one touch dialing features on all office telephones will route emergency calls directly to public safety office. (est. Spring 2012) Cameras are scheduled to be installed as part of Second Phases campus CCTV upgrade project. Increase staffing of public safety officers has been proposed to increase patrol in off-areas during off-hours.
