 - Curriculum Committee Report:
 - i. Occupational Therapy
 - a) *Revised Major Proposal*: To change the program's admissions criteria: GPA from 2.8-2.9.
 - b) To add a new requirement that all pre-requisite courses for the program be taken within the last 10 years.
 - ii. Performing and Fine Arts/Music
 - a) New Course Proposals: Music 279, 301, 453.
 - Music 279 and 301 are new courses to be cross-listed with the existing courses History 279 and TA 301. Both of these courses are WI.
 - **Music 453** The Globalization of Jazz is an entirely new course. These are intended to broaden the selection of courses available to Music students.
 - b) Course Change Proposals: Music 110, 239, 246, 339, 346, 439, 446
 - Music 110 Course title change from Basic Theory to Fundamentals of Theory
 - **Music 239, 246, 339, 346, 439, 446** pre-requisite is changed from 'Permission of Department' to "Audition Required."
 - c) *Course Change Proposal:* **TA 301**. Cross-listed with the new course Music 301, above.
 - d) Major and Minor revisions to incorporate changes above.
 - iii. History
 - a) Course Change Proposal: History 279. Cross-listed with Music 279 above.
 - iv. Teacher Education
 - a) Revised Major Designs: Anthropology Teacher Education (1-6), English Teacher Education (1-6), Interdisciplinary Studies Teacher Education (1-6), History Teacher Education (1-9) Extension proposed changes are consistent with those

made to the Childhood Education programs last year, **Music** Teacher Education (1-6), **Psychology** Teacher Education (1-6) - using PSY 215 as a substitute for EDUC 280, **Earth Science Education** (7-12) \rightarrow the changes in the major designs reflect the revisions previously approved for the different programs.

 - a) *Course Change Proposal:* **PE 358**. Change from 3 hours lecture to 2 hours lecture + 2 hours lab, with no net change in credits, as a response to accreditation requirement for a laboratory experience.
