1. New Courses

1.1 *Business and Economics: MA in Healthcare Administration*

- 1.1.1 BUS 505 – “Healthcare Operations and Process Improvement” focuses on healthcare challenges and improving operations.
- 1.1.2 BUS 510 – “Quality Assurance and Evaluation in Healthcare Administration” introduces students to regulatory standards in healthcare.
- 1.1.3 BUS 515 – “Informatics and Technologies in Healthcare Management” introduces students to healthcare data reporting systems.
- 1.1.4 BUS 525 – “Human Resource Management, Law and Ethics” provides overview of Human Resource Management in healthcare industry.
- 1.1.5 BUS 620 – “Leadership and Healthcare Management” introduces students to the benefits of effective healthcare management.
- 1.1.6 BUS 625 – “Strategic Planning in Healthcare Organizations” helps students understand the importance of long-term planning in healthcare.
- 1.1.7 ECON 610 – “Healthcare Economics and Financial Analysis” introduces best practices in healthcare financial management.
